



#### Typical Power Factor v Load






#### Typical THD v Load



#### Typical lout v Rset LEDset2 mode





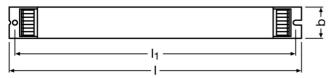
Typical Efficiency v Load 230 V 50 Hz
